## Selbusjøen Hotell & Gjestegård

### The History of Selbusjøen Hotel & Guesthouse

The property Haverneset in Selbu, which today is Selbusjøen Hotel & Guesthouse, has been an active place since 1850. The property was originally built for the businessman Birch, who established the tradingcentre in 1850

### Sightseeing along the road, travelling from Trondheim to Selbu

Hell trainstation. Many people stops to take pictures of the trainstation. The main reason for this is probably the name. On the stationbuilding, is a signpost saying "Hell Station".

### The Pilegrimslede

The main route for the pilgrims went trough Selbu, and is a path the pilgrims used on their walk from Uppsala in Sweden, to Nidaros Cathedral to be blessed and resived holy communion.

### Main Sights in Selbu:

Selbu Bygdemuseum, in the center of Selbu near the Selbu church, contains a large collection of historic items.

The Selbu-rose has become a worldwide trademark for Selbu. You can purchase handycrafts and souvenirs at Selbu Husflid

Also visit our galleries in the centre of Selbu. The Norwegian Radiomuseum is approx. 9 km from the hotel.

### Activities/experiences in Selbu:

Fishing in Nea, one of the best trout rivers in Northern Europe. You can borrow fishing boats at the hotel for the Selbulake. By the lake and near the 9-hole golfcourse, the hotel has a large barbeque area.

### Sightseeing along the road from Selbu to Røros

The cultural area Brekka – Kistafoss, situated by the road 705, between the villages Aune and Ås. The area includes farms, museums and an old powerstation near the river Nea. You will here find an old tydalsfarm. On the farmarea the play "Karolinernes hærtog i Tydal" are shown every other year.

**Græsli:** Monument over one of the largest findings of coins (1878) in Norway.

**Stugudalen:** The gate to Sytan, the summeroad to the lake Nesjøen and Nedalscottage, snowscooter-hire.

### Trondheim – Selbu:

The distance from Trondheim to Selbu is 66 km. Follow the road RV. 705 from Hell to Selbu.

### Sights in Trondheim:

Nidaros Cathedral, Munkholmen, Ringve museum and Trøndelag folkemuseum

### Distance from Røros:

From Selbu you carry on to Røros and the Vertshuset Røros. Drive road 705, turn right towards Tydal/Røros and follow the signpost for Røros. The distance is 148 km.

## Vertshuset Røros

### About Vertshuset Røros

Røros is a unique place. To really appreciate it, you have to open all your senses and be ready to listen – because the old mountain town is a place “where history whispers”. With its 333 years of mining history there is a lot to hear.

Røros is one of the oldest woodhouse towns in Europe, and one of few mining towns on UNESCO's list of world heritage(1980)

Vertshuset Røros is located in the old Rammgard in the middle of Røros. The Rammgard has a dramatic history, dating back to the 16th century.

Our rooms in the old wool factory show another part of the industrial history of Røros.

**The main building** became a bar and restaurant in 1967. The restaurant has recently been redecorated in traditional local style. We pride ourselves in our

kitchen. We use quality local produce to prepare gourmet meals, combining tradition with new ideas. While you enjoy your meal at Vertshuset, you should feel with all your senses that you are in Røros.

**Activities:** Guided tours of the town, the church; “Bergstadens Ziir”, Johan Falkberget's home; “Ratvolden”, the many arts and crafts shops in and around Røros, the museum; “Smelthytta”, the mine; Olavsgruva, fishing, horse sleigh rides, dog sled tours, walking in the beautiful national park “Femundsmarka”.

**Happenings:** The winter market; Rørosmartnan (February), Vinterfestspill i Bergstaden (chamber music festival in march), Elden (historic outdoors musical play in August) and Jenterittet (a bicycle ride for women; more details at [www.jenterittet.no](http://www.jenterittet.no))

The tour goes on from Røros to Kongs vold fjeldstue in Oppdal region. Drive down Kjerkgata turn left on RV30 and drive to the roundabout and then take the second on the right and keep on driving on RV30. Drive in on RV3 and turn right on RV 29. Drive in on E6 and you would arrive on Kongs vold Fjeldstue after a few minutes. The trip is 157,2 km.

## Kongsvoll Fjellstue



King Fredrik IV gave Kongsvoll its name in 1704. From the 12th century kings, queens, pilgrims, tradesmen artists and tourists of all kinds and nationalities have visited Kongsvoll on their way over the famous Dovrefjell. The last king to visit us was our present king Harald. We also had the

great honour to house queen Sonja and the Queen of Denmark when they were exploring the winter qualities of Kongsvoll. The hotel has been restored in collaboration with the National Antiquarian and local craftsmen and has 32 rooms with shower/toilet, authentic lounges and a diningroom for 70 guests. Kongsvoll consists of 20 well maintained buildings and the interior contain many antiques stemming from centuries of hotel operation. Kongsvoll is a historical experience. Here you may enjoy a pleasant stay, an exquisite cuisine and the tranquillity these original houses can give. Welcome to one of the oldest hotels in Norway. The tradition goes back to 1127, and we got royal privileges in 1670. The present houses are from 1720.

### Preferred activities:

After a nice drive from Røros through the Nord-Østerdal and Folldal, you arrive Kongsvoll. After arrival we recommend a walk in the botanical mountain-garden and among the historical buildings in Kongsvoll.

You are invited to a glass Champagne and a short briefing about Kongsvoll, before a four course Kongsvoll-dinner is served in the historical diningroom.

After a good night's sleep you enjoy a Norwegian breakfast and Moskox-safari. The Safari starts at 10 o'clock and lasts for about 5 hours. An authorised guide takes you into the Dovrefjell Nationalpark to find the famous animal. You need good walking shoes, warm and wind- and rainproof clothing. The safari is suitable for everyone that likes a good walk. Totally in the day the safari covers a distance of about 10 km in nice and light mountain-terrain.

If you should want to expand the stay in Kongsvoll, we can arrange other activities like: horseriding, fishing, golf, elk-safari, alpine and mountain skiing, nationalpark exhibition and museum visit, guided tour in botanical alpine garden and other on request.

### Itinerary / travelling route:

From Røros you take R30 via Os, Tolga and Tynset, then R3 towards Alvdal. Take R29 to Folldal and Hjerkin, then turn right and follow the E6 in 17 km to Kongsvoll. Total distance 163 km.

From Bårdshaug you take E39 to Fannrem, then R65 to Svorkmo, R700 via Løkken Verk up to Berkåk. There you take the E6 via Oppdal to Kongsvoll. Total distance 155 km.

## Bårdshaug Herregård

Manor and Modern Hotel



**Bårdshaug Herregård** is located in Orkanger, 40 km south-west of Trondheim, at the mouth of the **Salmon-river Orkla**.

**Bårdshaug Manor** and its history came right out of the fairytale book. It is the story of a dynasty, and mainly that

of one man who had ideas and used his energy to make projects come true – on a truly large scale.

Bårdshaug Herregård was built for **Consul-general Christian Thams** at the turn of the previous century. Christian Thams was a looming figure within business and diplomatic spheres.

Chr. Thams bought Bårdshaug Herregård in 1890

– it was originally the parsonage at Orkanger. He rebuilt the house in different styles and he drew the plans for the main building himself. The result was a distinctive manor house and a unique sight in the area – then as today.

The majestic manor house was the home of a man of the world, Christian Thams – architect, minister, landowner and consul.

Among his guests were both kings and princes: **Prince of Monaco, King Oscar II, King Haakon VII. King Olav V, King Harald and Queen Sonja, Crown-prince Haakon and Crown-princess Mette-Marit have been guests at Bårdshaug Herregård.**



**If you want** to expand your stay at Bårdshaug Herregård, we can arrange for Salmon-fishing in Orkla River, one of the most famous salmon-rivers in Norway. Salmon-season: 01.06 – 31.08.

### Preferred activities:

We recommend a stop at The Mine-society Løkken Verk where the Orkla Industrial Museum, The Old Mine and the worlds eldest narrow gauge railway is situated (the Thams Railway was founded by Christian Thams, and was opened in 1908 by King Haakon VII). The Old Mine offers a roundtrip into the late 18<sup>th</sup> century and onwards. In summer-season, it is possible to travel with the Thams Railway.

### Travelling Routes and Distances:

By car: 40 minutes from The Costal Steamer, one hour from Trondheim Airport Værnes, and 30 minutes from the center of Trondheim.

Route Trondheim – Orkanger: Take E6 from Trondheim, at Klett (about 10 km from the centre of Trondheim) take E39 to Orkanger.

Turnpike money: NOK 30.

If driving from Bårdshaug Herregård towards Kristiansund, continue south-west on E39, about 170 km, via Rindal and Surnadal. Ferry from Halså to Kanestraum and thereafter E39 (the Atlantic-Road ) towards Kristiansund.

Travelling Route: Kongsvoll Fjellstue – Bårdshaug Herregård: Total distance 155 km. Take E6 from Kongsvoll to Berkåk – R 700 from Berkåk to Orkanger.
